Energy can also be stored by making fuelssuch as hydrogen, which can be burned when energy is most needed. Pumped hydroelectricity, the most common form of large-scale energy storage, uses excess energy to pump water uphill, then releases the water later to turn a turbine and make electricity.

For plants with energy storage above 100 MWh or 5 h of capacity, underground storage is more cost-effective. Above ground storage (in gas pipes or pressure vessels) is practical for plants with less than 5-10 h of storage [67]. The project lead times for CAES plants range from one to three years, depending on the size.

CSP plants typically use two types of fluids: (1) heat-transfer fluid to transfer the thermal energy from the solar collectors through the pipes to the steam generator or storage, and (2) storage media fluid to store the thermal energy for a certain period of time before it is used on demand.
