

How much oil does Afghanistan produce a year?

Afghanistan has estimated reserves of 1,908 million barrels of crude oil +59 trillion cm of natural gas +667 million barrels of liquid gas. However, the country produces only 8,000 barrels of oil and 59 billion cm of gas per year. To compensate for this lack of domestic production, Afghanistan imported more than 4 million MTs of oil in 2014.

With hydrocarbon-rich Iran and Turkmenistan to its west, Afghanistan harbours around 1.6 billion barrels of crude oil, 16 trillion cubic feet of natural gas and another 500 million barrels of natural gas liquids.

Are Afghanistan's untapped oil and natural gas reserves bigger than previously thought?

Afghanistan's untapped oil and natural gas reserves may be significantly larger than previously thought, according to the results of a survey by the US Geological Survey (USGS) and the Afghan Ministry of Mining and Industry released in Washington on Tuesday.

How much is undiscovered oil worth in Afghanistan?

That's according to the 2019 Afghan report, which cited a joint U.S.-Afghan assessment, and implies a value of \$107 billion for the crude oil alone at current market prices. "Most of the undiscovered crude oil is in the Afghan-Tajik Basin and most of the undiscovered natural gas is in the Amu Darya Basin," the report said.

Will China drill for oil in Afghanistan?

Afghanistan's Taliban government is to sign a contract with a Chinese firm to drill for oil in the country's north. It would be the first major energy extraction agreement with a foreign firm since the Taliban took control of Afghanistan in 2021.
