#### Can a refrigerator be stored outside?

Leaving your fridge outside during the winter months is not recommended. If you're worried about the lack of space inside your home, there are other options available. You can opt for a mini-fridge or a cooler, or you can consider other storage solutions such as a garage, shed, or storage unit.

Store fridge upright, not on side. Also unpack and examine each appliance for damage upon delivery even if packaging looks good. Any damages have to be reported within 24 hours of delivery especially for cosmetic damage ie dents and scratches. All brands can and will deny replacement if later than 24 hours reporting

Depending on the electrical circuit, you can check if there is already a GFCI protection in place. Sometimes receptacles may be wired downstream of an outlet that already has a GFCI protection installed, which would mean that this outlet provides GFCI protection to the rest of the receptacles down the circuit.
