Will China expand its energy storage capacity by 2025?

China aims to further develop its new energy storage capacity, which is expected to advance from the initial stage of commercialization to large-scale development by 2025, with an installed capacity of more than 30 million kilowatts, regulators said.

How much energy will China generate by 2025?

China is aiming for 50% electricity generation from renewable power by 2025, up from 42% currently. China is targeting a non-hydro energy storage installed capacity of 30GW by 2025 and grew its battery production output for energy storage by 146% last year, state media has said.

How will China's storage market grow in 2025?

China, coming in second after the US, is expected to see its cumulative energy storage capacity grow exponentially, with a CAGR of 36% by 2025.

How big is China's battery energy storage capacity?

China is targeting installed battery energy storage capacity of 30GW by 2025 and grew its battery production for storage 146% last year.

Will China cut the cost of electrochemical energy storage systems?

The country aims to cut the cost of electrochemical energy storage systems by 30% by 2025, according to a five-year plan released by the National Development and Reform Commission and the National Energy Administration.

Will energy storage cost decrease by 30 percent by 2025?

“While the cost-learning curve is still relatively slow now, the 14th Five-Year-Plan (2021-25) has made a clear goal for the per unit cost of energy storage to decrease by 30 percent by 2025. This will hopefully accelerate the industry pace.” China is currently the world's biggest power generator.

As shown in the graph below, some provinces will see nearly 100 GW of installed ESS capacity by 2025. More provincial governments introduced regulations for the generation side, the grid side, and the end user side. Until 2025, China's energy storage industry is expected to see rapid expansions.
