

# Energy storage capacity explained

What is the power capacity of a battery energy storage system?

As of the end of 2022, the total nameplate power capacity of operational utility-scale battery energy storage systems (BESSs) in the United States was 8,842 MW and the total energy capacity was 11,105 MWh. Most of the BESS power capacity that was operational in 2022 was installed after 2014, and about 4,807 MW was installed in 2022 alone.

What is an energy storage system?

An energy storage system (ESS) for electricity generation uses electricity (or some other energy source, such as solar-thermal energy) to charge an energy storage system or device, which is discharged to supply (generate) electricity when needed at desired levels and quality. ESSs provide a variety of services to support electric power grids.

Why is energy storage important?

Energy storage is a potential substitute for, or complement to, almost every aspect of a power system, including generation, transmission, and demand flexibility. Storage should be co-optimized with clean generation, transmission systems, and strategies to reward consumers for making their electricity use more flexible.

What is storage duration?

Storage duration is the amount of time storage can discharge at its power capacity before depleting its energy capacity. For example, a battery with 1 MW of power capacity and 4 MWh of usable energy capacity will have a storage duration of four hours.

What is the difference between rated power capacity and storage duration?

Rated power capacity is the total possible instantaneous discharge capability (in kilowatts [kW] or megawatts [MW]) of the BESS, or the maximum rate of discharge that the BESS can achieve, starting from a fully charged state. Storage duration is the amount of time storage can discharge at its power capacity before depleting its energy capacity.

Energy (Watt-hours) = Capacity (amp-hours) x Voltage (volts) Let's look at an example using the equation above -- if a battery has a capacity of 3 amp-hours and an average voltage of 3.7 volts, the total energy stored in that battery is 11.1 watt-hours -- 3 amp-hours (capacity) x 3.7 volts (voltage) = 11.1 watt-hours (energy).

A battery's energy capacity can be calculated by multiplying its voltage (V) by its nominal capacity (Ah) and the result will be in Wh/kWh. If you have a 100Ah 12V battery, then the Wh it has can be calculated as 100Ah x 12V = 1200Wh or 1.2kWh. Note that Watt-hours (Wh) = energy capacity, while ampere-hours (Ah) = charge capacity.

Amp-Hours (Ah): Capacity of a Battery. Amp-hours (Ah) is a measure of a battery's capacity, indicating how much charge it can hold. A higher Ah rating means a battery can provide power for a longer duration. For example, a 200Ah lithium battery can supply a certain amount of current for a longer time compared to a battery with a lower Ah rating.
