When you head out to buy a new external graphics card for your laptop, you might run into some jargon--specifically, eGPU, which we've covered, and eGFX, which we haven't. eGFX stands for "external graphics" and means the eGPU dock you're going to buy is a Thunderbolt 3 unit, which delivers faster data than a non-Thunderbolt 3 unit, therefore ...

Since you've had problems even with the graphics card removed and running on the iGPU, that suggests that the problem IS likely the power supply and not the graphics card, but the fact is it is not uncommon to have BOTH fail simultaneously especially if you've been running a graphics card with a low end power supply for a long period of time.
