

#### What is a battery energy storage system?

A battery energy storage system (BESS) is an electrochemical device that charges (or collects energy) from the grid or a power plant and then discharges that energy at a later time to provide electricity or other grid services when needed.

#### What is a 500 kw/2 MWh energy storage system?

For instance,a 500 kW/2 MWh energy storage system incorporates a 500 kW PCS,a 2 MWh energy storage battery unit and some BMSs. The PCS is mainly used to control the charge/discharge power and manage protection functions. The BMS is mainly used to manage the operation and control of the 2 MWh energy storage battery.

#### What is energy storage capacity?

It can be compared to the output of a power plant. Energy storage capacity is measured in megawatt-hours(MWh) or kilowatt-hours (kWh). Duration: The length of time that a battery can be discharged at its power rating until the battery must be recharged.

#### What is energy storage system?
