

What is energy storage system?

How do battery energy storage systems work? Although using energy storage is never 100% efficient--some energy is always lost in converting energy and retrieving it--storage allows the flexible use of energy at different times from when it was generated. So, storage can increase system efficiency and resilience, and it can improve power quality by matching supply and demand.

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
