For the battery-flywheel system, the battery had a size of 260 kWh and the flywheel had a capacity of 180 kW. For the rSOC-battery architecture, the battery had a capacity of 450 kWh and the rSOC featured a power of up to 80 kW. The scientists assumed a cost of EUR970 (\$1,058)/kW for the PV system and a cost of EUR411/kWh for the batteries.

The flywheel energy storage operating principle has many parallels with conventional battery-based energy storage. The flywheel goes through three stages during an operational cycle, like all types of energy storage systems: The flywheel speeds up: this is the charging process.

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
