How long do motor oil bottles last?

Opened bottles of both synthetic and conventional motor oils would have a similar lifespan. Condensation- After the seal on the bottle has been broken, the interior is more prone to condensation. Once the oil level in the bottle is lowered, there is more open space for condensation to develop.

How long should engine oil be stored?

That being said, I would not recommend storing engine oil for more than a few years, since the additives in the oil can begin to settle out of the oil. Store it, as already said, in a dry location with fairly stable temperature and humidity, but don't hold on to it for 5-10 years: engine oil does eventually break down. Settle out?

How do you store motor oil?

Store motor oil in a dry location away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The ideal storage temperature for motor oil is between 40°F and 85°F (4°C and 29°C). Keep motor oil containers tightly sealed to prevent moisture and other contaminants from entering. Use the original container to store motor oil.

But what if the bottle is only half-opened?

This prevents any changes in the oil due to contact with oxygen. According to legal rules, unopened oil has a shelf life of two years.
