

Can you store pantry items in deep cabinets?

They ensure you always have immediate access to any item you need with a simple turn. I recommend storing a category of pantry items on a single Lazy Susan.

How do you store items in a bathroom cabinet?

Make sure you have enough binders to accommodate all the documents you want to organize. Consider the size and capacity of the binders based on the amount of paper you need to store. Store your long-term drinking water storage containers in a relatively cool place. Avoid heat, which may promote growth of algae, etc. A good rule-of-thumb is ideally between 50 - 70°F. I keep mine on the 1st-floor slab where it's always cool. Some suggest to keep water containers from direct contact with concrete (long term).

You can buy a fancy storage rack or make one of your own. But either way, you're giving up precious wall space until spring. Here's a quick solution: Screw short sections of wire shelving to your ceiling.

Different foods require different storage methods. Food that is low in fat and has a low moisture content (less than 10%) will last the longest and is the best to store long term. Examples that are not good to store long term in Mylar bags are nuts, fruits, vegetables, chocolate, crackers, granola, beef jerky, and popcorn.

Cabinet and Shelving Units: Cabinets and shelving units can be stored for extended periods with adequate precautions. Ensure the interior of cabinets is clean and dry, and remove any loose or fragile items from shelves.
