There are a lot of theories about how to best store a boat for winter. Some are sound. Others, not so much. Beware of these winter boat storage myths that can lead you astray. Myth: You should wrap the engine's gearcase/lower unit with a plastic yard waste bag, then use duct tape to seal it off. This prevents water intrusion and weathering.
