Renewable penetration and state policies supporting energy storage growth Grid-scale storage continues to dominate the US market, with ERCOT and CAISO making up nearly half of all grid-scale installations over the next five years.

#### Will energy storage grow in 2024?

#### What is the DOE's energy storage goal?

WASHINGTON,D.C. -- U.S. Secretary of Energy Jennifer M. Granholm today announced the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE)'s new goal to reduce the cost of grid-scale,long duration energy storage by 90% within the decade.

What is long duration energy storage?

Long duration energy storage - defined as systems that can store energy for more than 10 hours at a timewould support a low-cost, reliable, carbon-free electric grid.

Which energy storage technologies are included in the 2020 cost and performance assessment?

The 2020 Cost and Performance Assessment provided installed costs for six energy storage technologies: lithium-ion (Li-ion) batteries, lead-acid batteries, vanadium redox flow batteries, pumped storage hydro, compressed-air energy storage, and hydrogen energy storage.

Why are annual storage installations growing faster than wind and solar?

Annual storage installations are growing faster than wind and solar as the sector races to keep up with the growing need to balance renewables and support grid resiliency. The storage market is also supported by falling module costs and IRA tax incentives.

The DOE"s Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy provides useful data to understand the costs of solar-plus-storage and how duration of storage impacts cost. Pacific Northwest National Laboratory's 2020 Grid Energy Storage Technologies Cost and Performance Assessment provides a range of cost estimates for technologies in 2020 and 2030 as well as a framework to help break down different cost categories of energy storage systems.

Energy storage system costs stay above \$300/kWh for a turnkey four-hour duration system. In 2022, rising raw material and component prices led to the first increase in energy storage system costs since BNEF started its ESS cost survey in 2017. Costs are expected to remain high in 2023 before dropping in 2024.
