Per capita energy consumption was 0.9 toe/cap in 2022 (i.e. 73% below the Middle East average) and per capita electricity consumption nearly 1 600 kWh (62% lower than in the region). Total energy consumption has halved since 2017, including -16% in 2022 to 4.7 Mtoe.
