Pumped storage hydropower (PSH) is a type of hydroelectric energy storage. It is a configuration of two water reservoirs at different elevations that can generate power as water moves down from one to the other (discharge),passing through a turbine. The system also requires power as it pumps water back into the upper reservoir (recharge).

### What is pumped Energy Storage?

The PSPS is the best tool for energy storage. The pumped storage has the function of energy reserve, and it solves the problem of electricity production and consumption at the same time, and not easy to store. Thus, it can effectively regulate the dynamic balance of the power systems in electricity generation and utilization.

### Are pumped storage power stations a good long-term energy storage tool?

The high penetration of renewable energy sources (RESs) in the power system stresses the need of being able to store energy in a more flexible manner. This makes pumped storage power station the most attractive long-term energy storage tool today[4,5].

The basic operation principle of a pumped-storage plant is that it converts electrical energy from a grid-interconnected system to hydraulic potential energy (so-called "charging") by pumping the water from a



lower reservoir to an upper one during the off-peak periods, and then converts it back ("discharging") by exploiting the available hydraulic potential ...

Pumped hydroelectric storage facilities store energy in the form of water in an upper reservoir, pumped from another reservoir at a lower elevation.
