

Will Sao Tome rehabilitate the water sector?

In line with Government's strategy to revive the water sector, the project will build and rehabilitate infrastructure at the country's main water intake sources: the Agua Agriao and Agua Amoreira situated in the capital Sao Tome.

What is so Tom's famous for?

Where is so Tom's located?

It rises to 2,024 metres (6,640 feet) at Pico de S's Tom's and includes the capital city, S's Tom's, on the northeast coast. The nearest city on mainland Africa is the port city of Port Gentil in Gabon located 240 kilometres (150 miles) to the east.
