How do I Keep my Social Security card safe?

Keep it in a safe place. Store your card in a secure drawer or safe with other valuable documents like your birth certificate. Don't present your card if you don't have to. Except for government agencies like the Department of Motor Vehicles and the IRS, even sharing your Social Security number is voluntary.

Do I need a replacement Social Security card?

A federal law requires you to provide your SSN to get a particular benefit or service. You can replace your Social Security card for free if it is lost or stolen. However, you may not need to get a replacement card. Knowing your Social Security number is what is important.

Do all cards show my Name & Social Security number?

All cards show your name and Social Security number. If you are not a U.S. Citizen or lawful permanent resident, you may have a work restriction listed on your card. Can I replace my Social Security card for free?

You can replace your Social Security card for free if it is lost or stolen. However, you may not need to get a replacement card. Knowing your Social Security number is what's important. You are limited to three (3) replacement cards in a year and 10 during your lifetime. Legal name changes do not count toward these limits.

Should I Keep my Social Security card?

While you could easily go your whole life without having to produce your Social Security card, it's a good thing to keep on hand. There are some simple steps to keep it secure. Don't carry it in your wallet. It's not considered a valid ID and could easily get lost or stolen.

Should I Carry my Social Security card every day?

We encourage you not to carry your Social Security card with you every day. The best way to "Guard Your Card" is to keep it in a safe place and share it only when required, which is rare. In fact, in most cases, just knowing the Social Security number should be enough.
